Bob Moore celebrates his 82nd, and you're invited

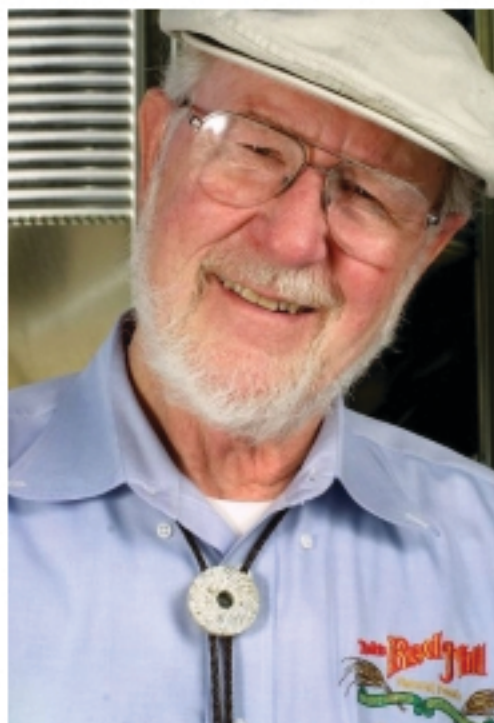
Bob's Red Mill founder holding a birthday bash in Milwaukie
